Making a Big Difference in Winston-Salem, NC

The city of Winston-Salem has scheduled to decommission the gun detection technology ShotSpotter at the end of September 2024. ShotSpotter listens and alerts first responders to gunfire incidents in less than a minute, so they can respond quickly, get to the scene, and save lives.

What is ☐ ShotSpotter®?

Police rely on the community to call 9-1-1 if gunshots are fired, but only 20% of incidents are ever reported on average. This creates a situation where police departments have a large data gap that makes it difficult to be able to effectively "serve and protect" when it comes to gun violence. SoundThinking's ShotSpotter acoustic gunshot detection technology fills the gap with a network of acoustic sensors that can detect, locate, and alert police to nearly all gunshot incidents. The system is in operation in more than 170 cities and is used by police to:

- Be able to respond to a higher percentage of gunfire incidents;
- Improve response times to crime scenes to better aid victims and find witnesses; and
- Help police locate key evidence to identify and investigate suspects
